PROJECT NAME:

International SDR Security Services API

PROJECT GOALS:

To develop an internationally available standard application programming interface for accessing the security services inherent in a radio subsystem, including the authentication services and cryptographic subsystem.

DESIRED OUTCOME:

An application programming interface that is widely adopted by the international community, fostering an ecosystem of vendors that support interoperable security service technologies, creating economies of scale for radio developers and reducing their overall costs. As a follow up project, the SDR Forum may initiate a certification testing activity for products supporting the developed API to ensure interoperability.
