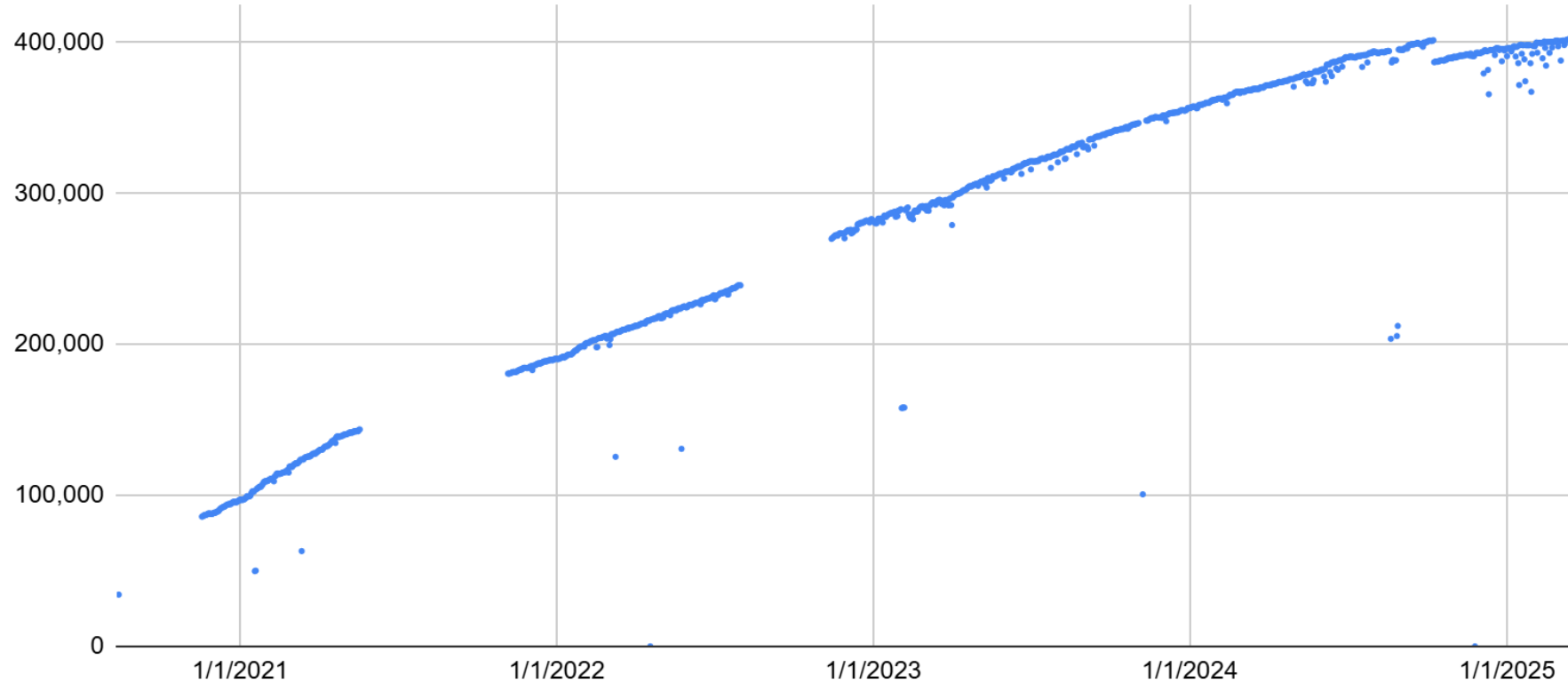

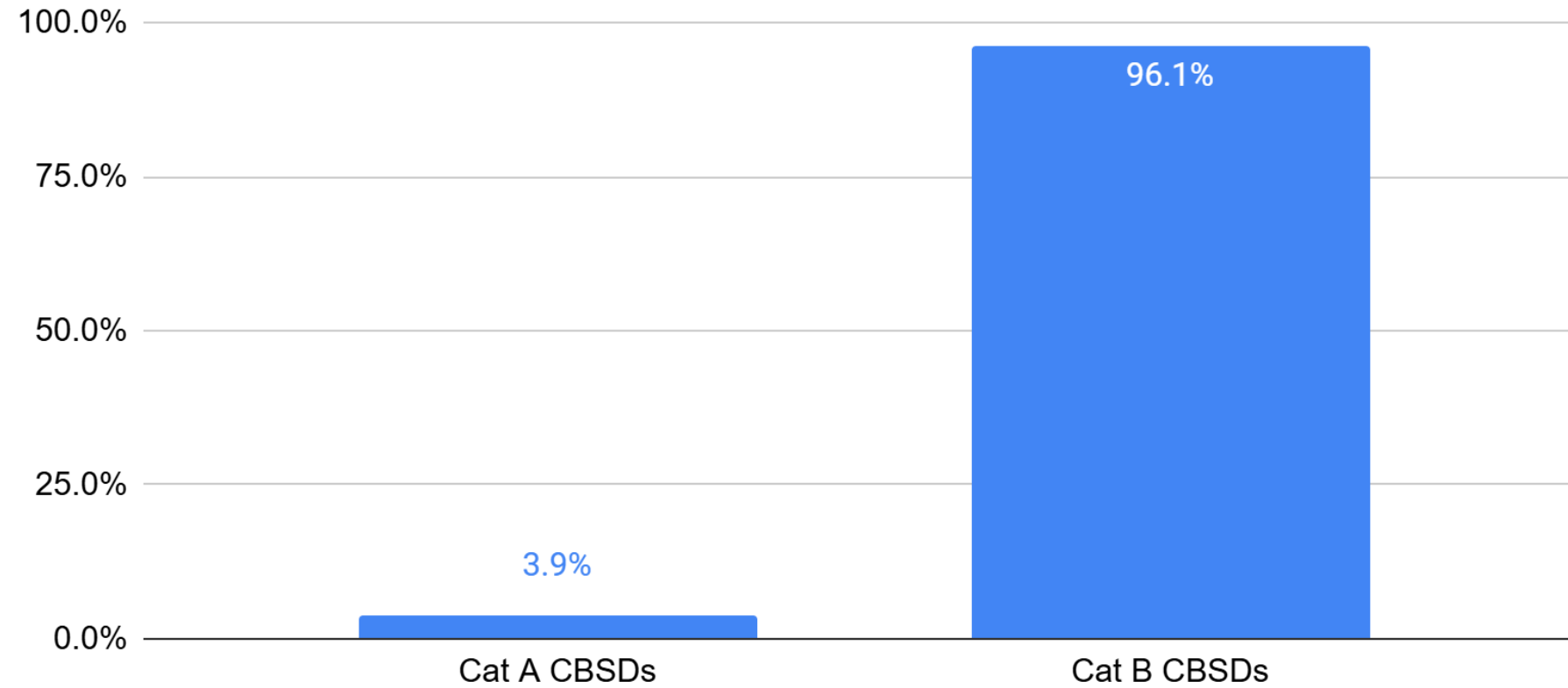
- This presentation documents various statistics related to CBRS deployments

Number of CBSDs over Time

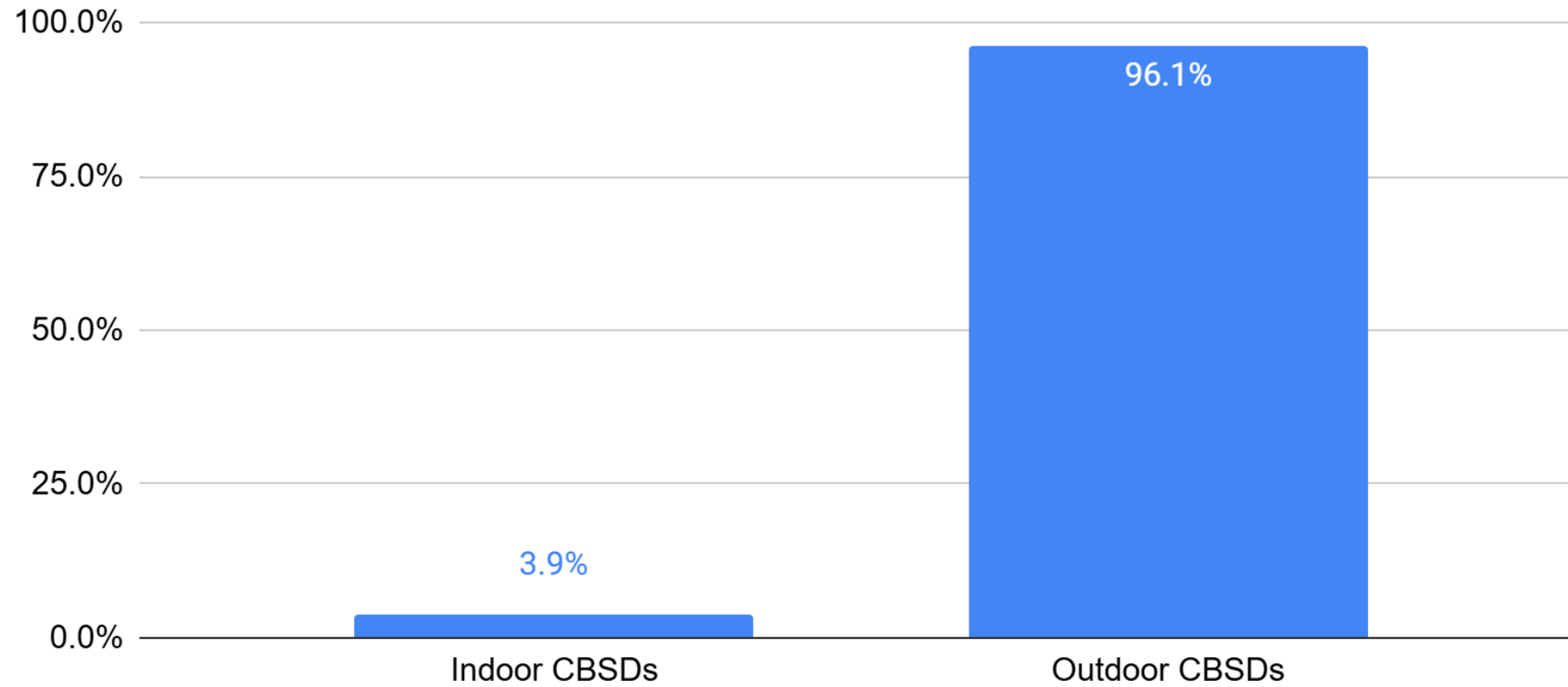


- Number of CBSDs with one or more unexpired grants
- Count as of March 7, 2025: 401,257
- Manually-retrieved data archive has occasional periods of missing data, but trend is clear
- Drop-outs are due to occasional issues with nightly FAD exchange

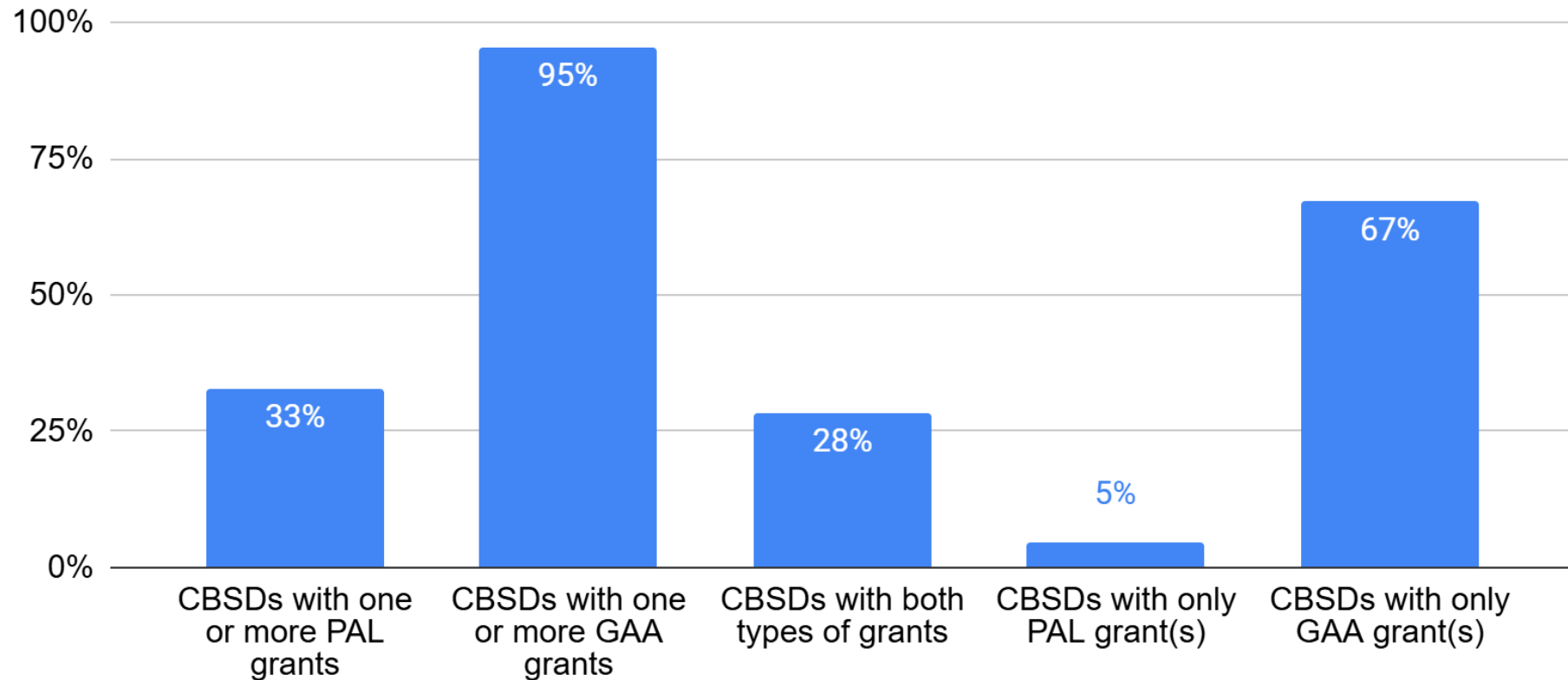
CBSDs by Category



CBSDs by Indoor/Outdoor

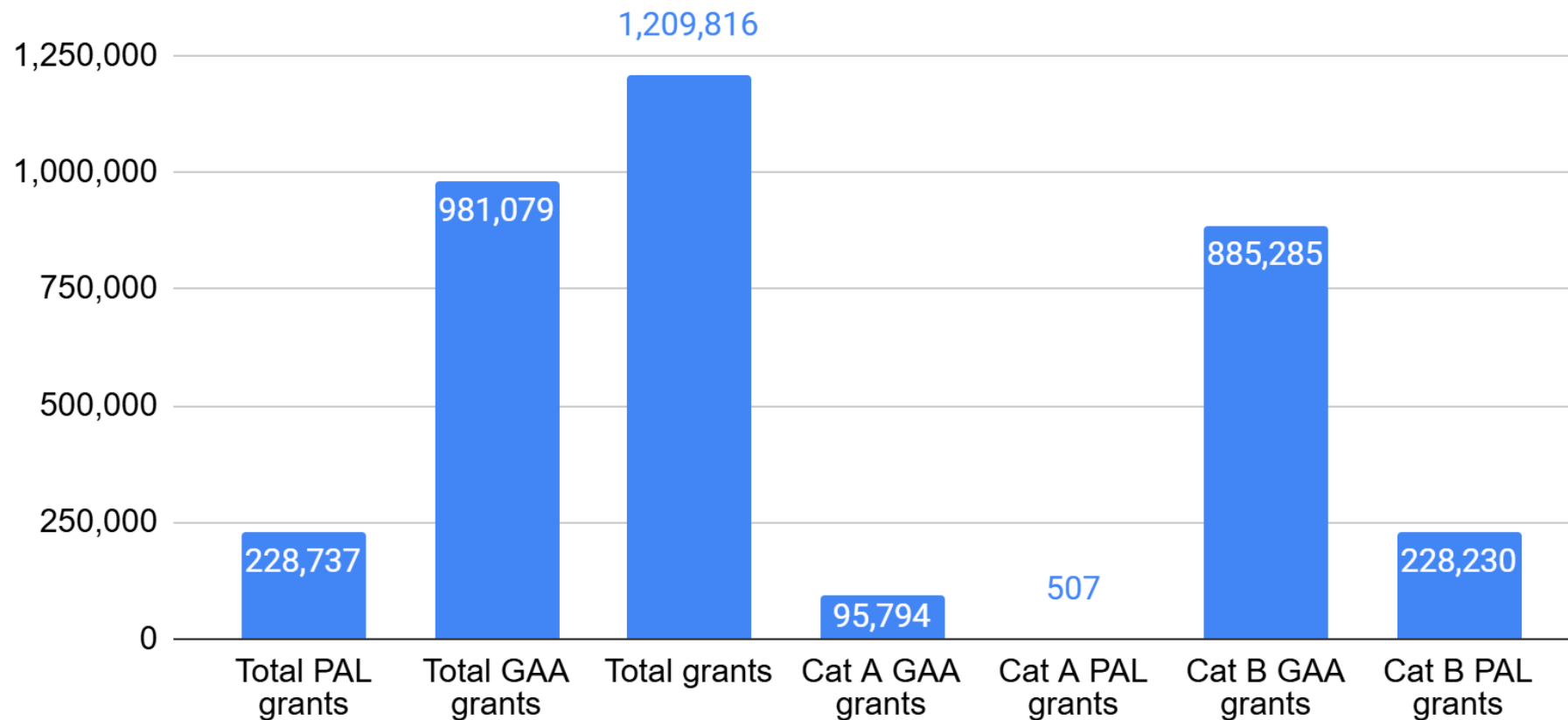


PAL and GAA Frequency Grants



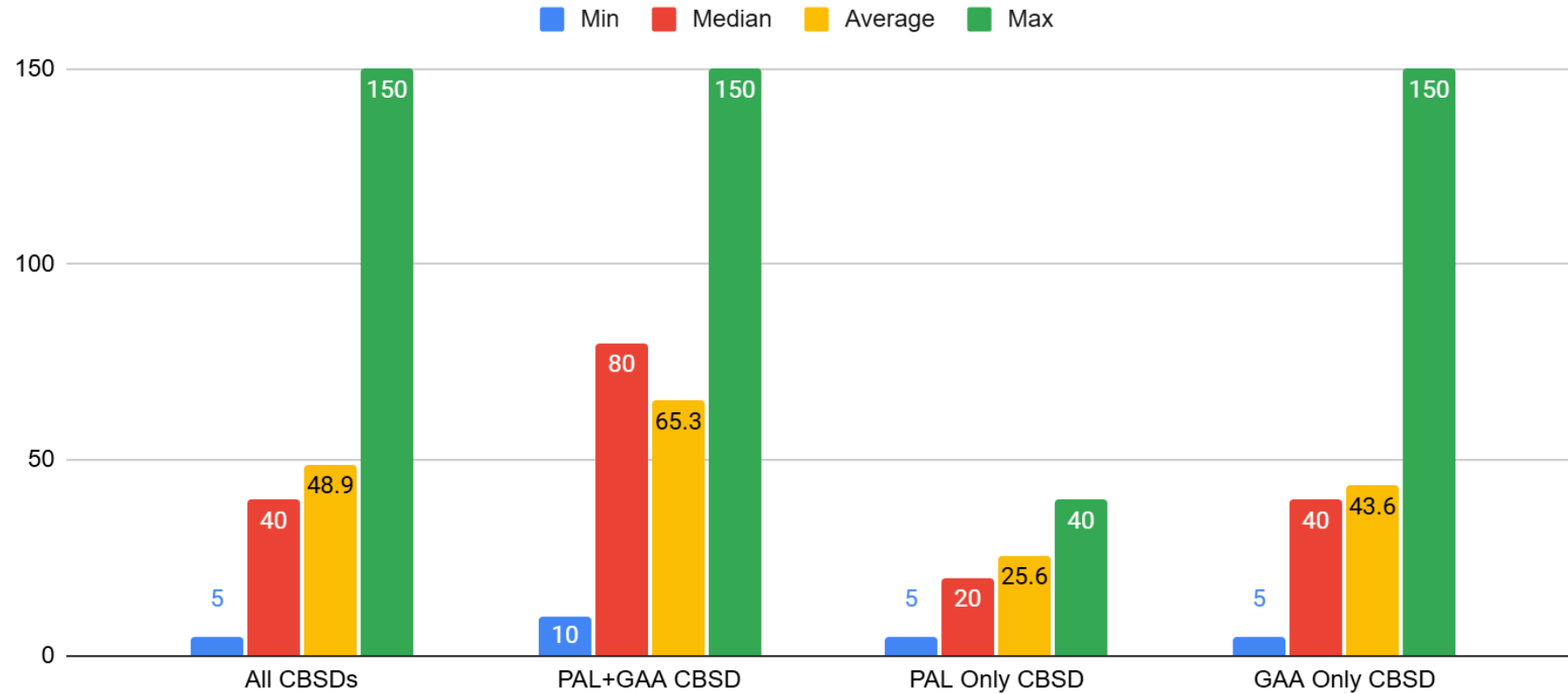
- “PAL” or “GAA” is determined by the frequency grant, not by the CBSD
- A CBSD can have more than one frequency grant
- A CBSD can have PAL grant(s), GAA grant(s), or a combination of the two

Number of Total Grants

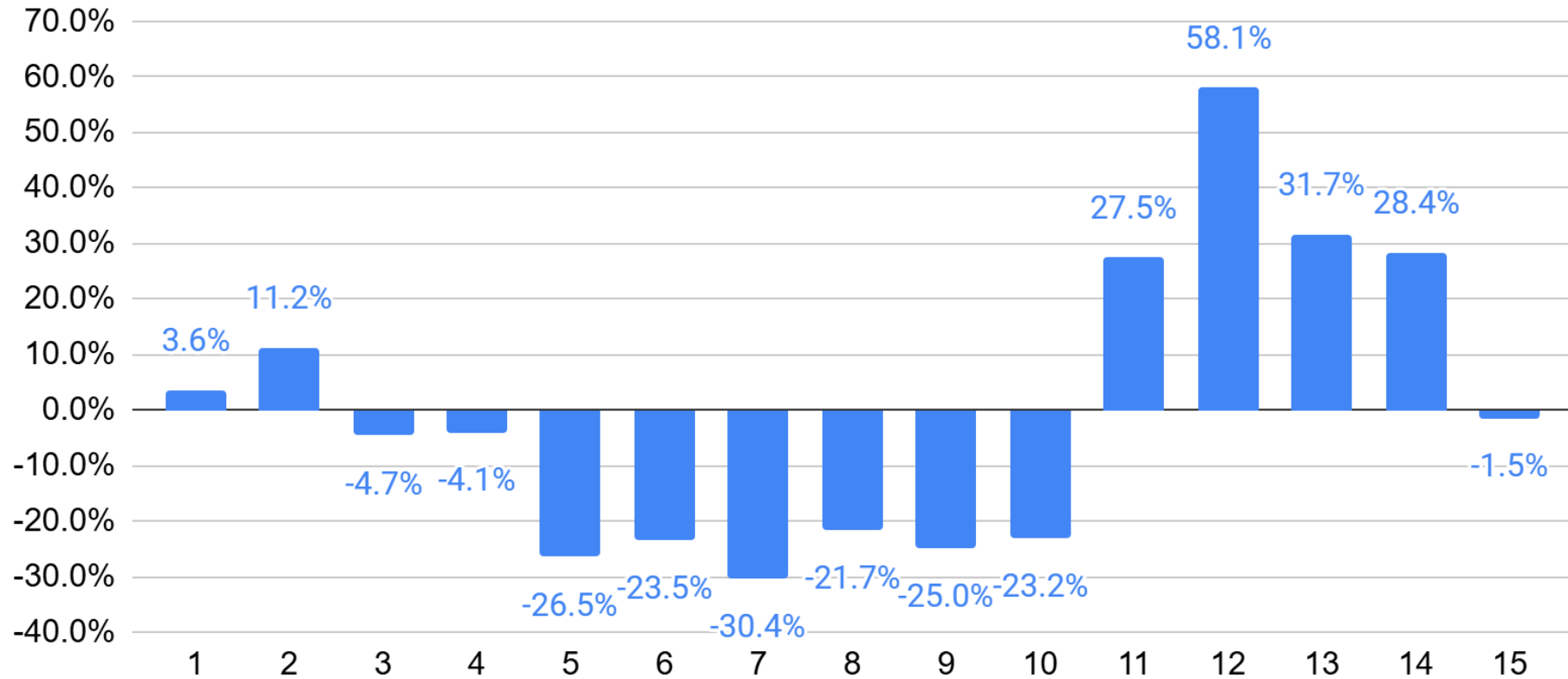


- Average number of grants per CBSD: 3.0
- Median number of grants per CBSD: 2.0

Total Granted Bandwidth per CBSD (MHz)

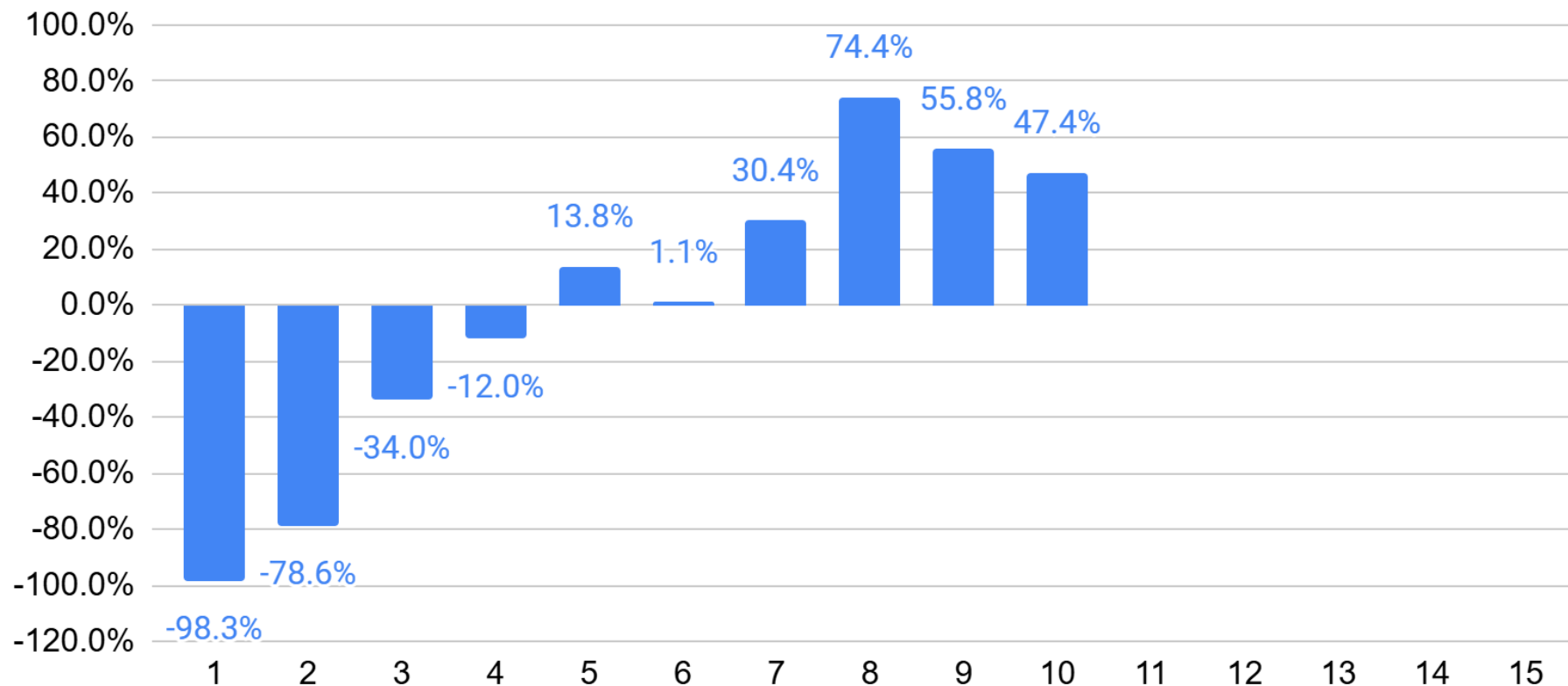


GAA Grants per Channel



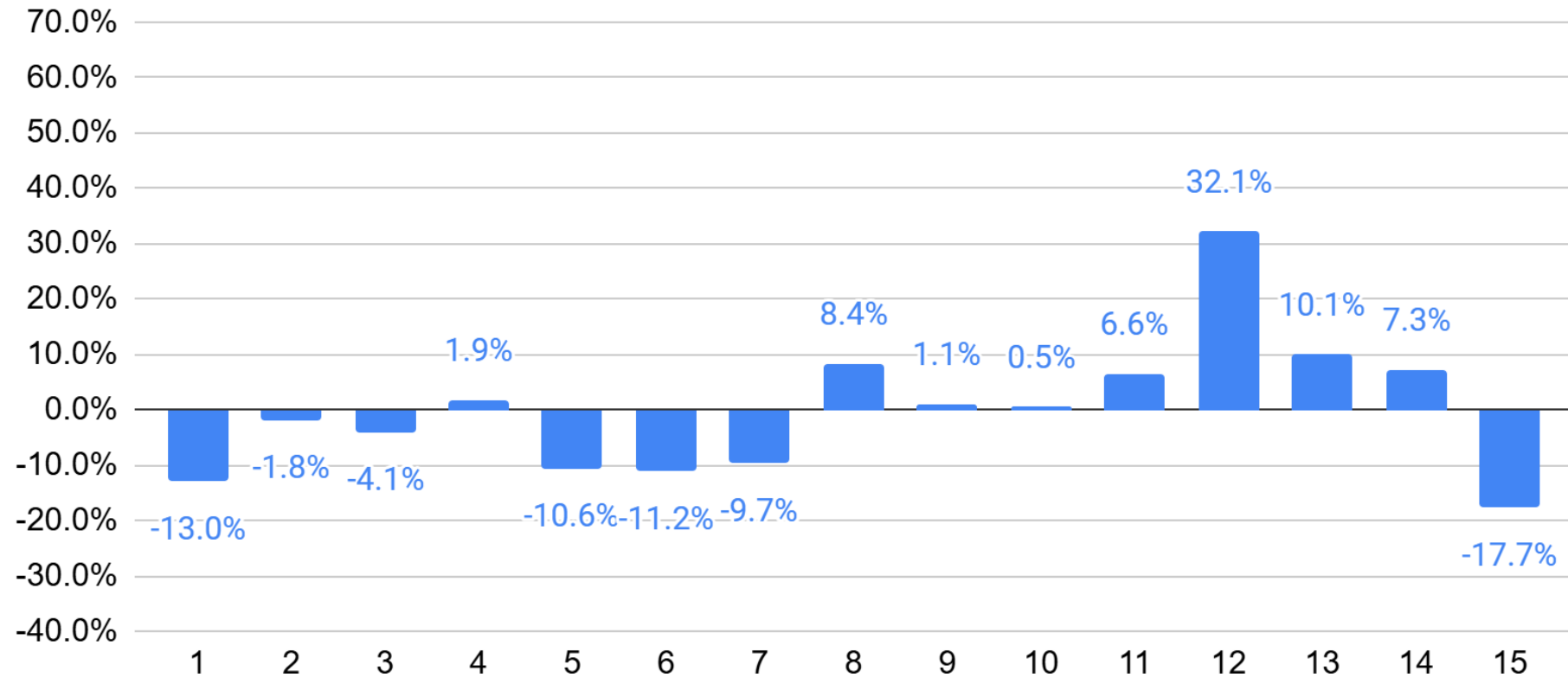
- Displaying GAA grants per channel compared to the overall average number of GAA grants per channel (65,405)
- Note: PAL grants not allowed on channel 11-15

PAL Grants per Channel



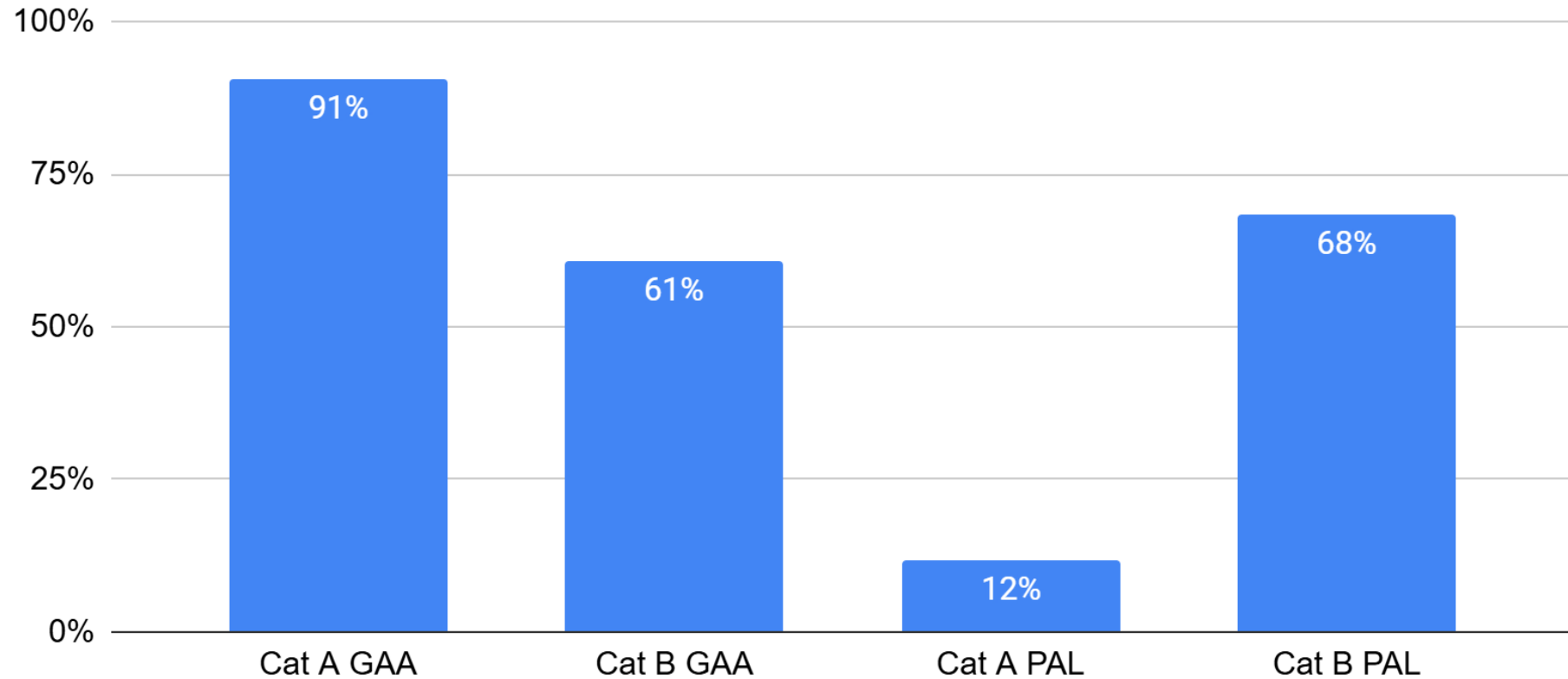
- Displaying PAL grants per channel compared to the overall average number of PAL grants per channel (22,874)

All Grants per Channel



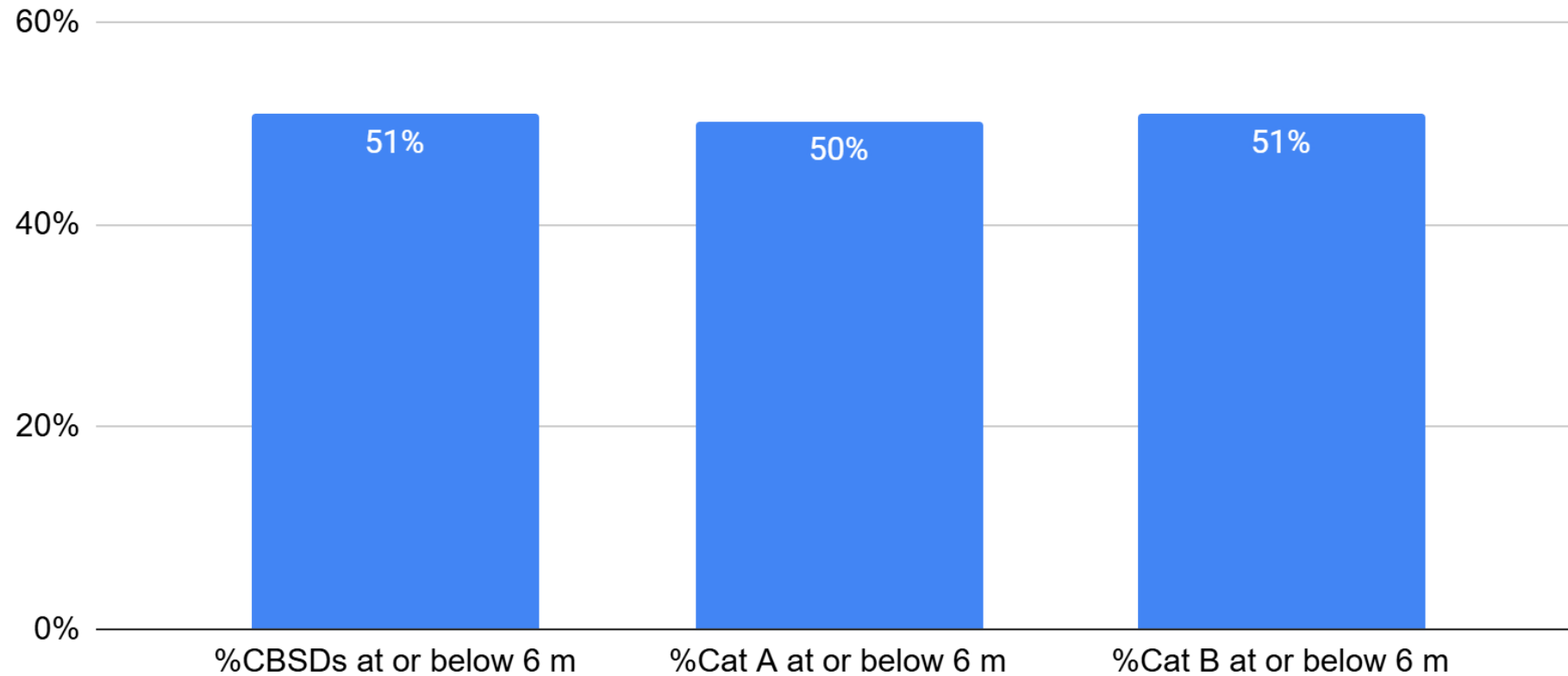
- Displaying grants per channel compared to overall average number of grants per channel (80,654)

Fraction of Grants Authorized within 1 dB of Max Allowed Power



- Cat A full power: 30 dBm per 10 MHz (0.1 W/MHz)
- Cat B full power: 47 dBm per 10 MHz (5 W/MHz)

Fraction of CBSDs Installed at or below 6 m AGL



- Maximum “CBRS 2.0” advantages kick in for CBSDs at or below 6 m Above Ground Level (AGL)
