Wireless Innovation Forum Inclusive Language Policies and Procedures Version 1.0 Approved by the Board of Directors on 9 September 2021

It shall be the policy of the Software Defined Radio Forum, Inc. d/b/a the Wireless Innovation Forum (WInnForum) to promote the use of inclusive language in all published materials, including the reports, recommendations, and specification created by it's members.

Therefore:

- 1. The WInnForum will maintain a list as an appendix to this policy (Appendix 1) of words or phrases (terms) considered to be non-inclusive and proposed alternatives to those terms (hereafter "the list"). The date an alternative term is adopted will be included with each term.
- 2. The Governance Committee will periodically review the list and determine if changes should be made, according to their Duty of Care¹ and taking into consideration submissions from WInnForum members.
 - a. Such review could take into consideration similar policies made by other standards organizations.
- 3. Staff will work with the technical editor of each document to ensure this policy is appropriately followed.
 - a. Referenced source material can be presented as is, without modification.
 - b. Text that is derived from reference material should be modified to meet with this policy where possible.
- 4. This policy only applies to materials published after the date of approval of this policy by the Board of Directors.
- 5. Materials published prior to this date will not be subject to this policy.
 - a. Any report, recommendation, or specification that goes through technical revision will be revised following this policy unless determined otherwise by the Board of Directors.
